Apple Pay is also designed to protect your personal information. Apple doesn't

store or have access to the original credit, debit, or prepaid card numbers that

you use with Apple Pay. And when you use Apple Pay with credit, debit, or pre

paid cards, Apple doesn't retain any transaction information that can be ti

ed back to you. Your transactions stay between you, the merchant or developer, a

nd your bank or card issuer.

To securely transmit your payment information when you pay in apps or on the web

, Apple Pay receives your encrypted transaction and re-encrypts it with a develo

per-specific key before the transaction information is sent to the developer or

payment processor. This key helps ensure that only the app or the website that y

ou're purchasing from can access your encrypted payment information. Website

s must verify their domain every time they offer Apple Pay as a payment option.

Like with in-store payments, Apple sends your Device Account Number to the app o

r website along with the transaction-specific dynamic security code. Neither App

le nor your device sends your actual payment card number to the app.

When you use Apple Pay on your iPhone or Apple Watch to confirm a purchase from

your Mac in Safari, your Mac and the authorizing device communicate over an encr

rypted channel via Apple servers. Apple doesn't retain any of this informatio

n in a form that personally identifies you. You can disable the ability to use A

pple Pay on your Mac in Settings on your iPhone. Go to Wallet & Apple Pay an

d turn off Allow Payments On Mac.

If you sign up for a rewards card and provide information to the merchant, such

as your name, postal code, email address, and phone number, Apple will receive n

otification of the signup, but the information that you share will be sent direc

tly from your device to the merchant and is treated in accordance with the merch

ant's privacy policy.

Erasing your device remotely using Find My also removes the ability to pay with

the cards that you were using with Apple Pay. Your credit, debit, and prepaid ca

rd cards will be suspended from Apple Pay by your bank, your bank's authorized se

rvice provider, your card issuer, or your issuer's authorized service provid

er, even if your device is offline and not connected to a cellular or Wi-Fi netw

ork. If you find your device, you can add the cards again using Wallet.
